What you’re sipping is an honest wine with natural character, so you can discover your taste, one glass at a time.

SINGLE VINEYARD

2021 LA REYNA BLANCA CHARDONNAY

The 2021 wine vintage had below average winter precipitation, with early budbreak in late March, normal to slightly early bloom in late May and early June, and small clusters with generally low yields. The heat in late June resulted in higher sugars but lagging flavor development and phenolic ripeness. Acidity was relatively low compared to average. Cool Fall temperatures allowed for flavor to catch up while sugar accumulation plateaued.

White wines from this vintage are ripe and rich, while red wines are intensely concentrated with great structure. Vineyards used sustainable farming practices with reduced yields to concentrate flavors and encourage complete expressions of ripeness. Chardonnay Clones used were 76, 95, and 96. The fruit was brought in cold, fermented slowly in barrels, stirred on its lees every week. The wine underwent full malolactic fermentation, and was bottled unfined and unfiltered.

“The 2021 Single Barrel ‘La Reyna Blanca’ comes from a small site that is planted to three clones of Chardonnay. Very golden in the glass 2021 Chardonnay offers amazing concentration and bright underlying acidity. Lemon zest and creme brûlée flavors greet you alongside marzipan and a near minute long finish. A stunning bottling, this will live on for another ten years.”

2021 SOLAKSEN PINOT NOIR

The 2021 vintage was marked by challenging weather conditions, leading to low yields. Despite the limited yields caused by the heat in June, the vines demonstrated resilience under intense stress, resulting in a healthy crop.

The Single Barrel Solaksen Pinot Noir, predominantly made from Solaksen Vineyard clones 114, 115, 777, 91, and 667, showcased careful winemaking techniques. The delay in harvesting until October allowed the flavors to develop while maintaining a sense of freshness in the wine.

The wine underwent cold soaking and 30-day extended maceration. After which, it matured for 20 months in a mix of mostly used French oak barrique. The resulting wine was bottled unfined and unfiltered to maintain its pure and vibrant nature. This meticulous process ensured that the 2021 Single Barrel Solaksen Pinot Noir captured the unique character of both vintage and varietal.

“The 2021 ‘Solaksen’ Pinot Noir comes off as very concentrated in the glass. This saw a high percentage of stem inclusion during the fermentation process. Stored in only 10% new French oak barrels, this offers cola and juicy red cherry tones on the nose alongside shades of black truffle shavings. The palate is rich and concentrated with good underlying finesse and weight. Pretty red fruit flavors combine with suggestions of tilled salty soils, and iodine. Fresh and fragrant, this beauty is showing really well right now.”

2022 ROYAL SLOPE GRENACHE

Grenache has long captivated wine lovers with its perfume, lift, and textural allure. Rooted in the south of France in places like the Southern Rhône and Provence, it anchors classics such as Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Gigondas, and Vacqueyras. In the United States, plantings were sparse for decades, appearing in select pockets of California where a few pioneers revealed its red-fruited elegance, spice, and graceful texture. In the right hands, Grenache brings silk, brightness, and savory detail that feels timeless.

Now along the Royal Slope, a high-elevation bench along the Frenchman Hills, plantings of Grenache remain limited yet increasingly focused. South and southwest exposures, steady winds, and well-drained loess over basalt encourage even ripening, while dramatic day-to-night temperature swings preserve lift and fine tannin. These ideal conditions reward careful farming and gentle extraction, yielding wines with red fruit purity, white-pepper spice, and a chalk-tinged finish. We are fortunate to work alongside a handful of thoughtfully chosen parcels on the Royal Slope to let this place speak clearly in the glass.

The 2022 Single Barrel Royal Slope Grenache was crafted from the Thunderstone and Corfu Crossing vineyards within this dynamic AVA.

The winemaking team worked with our vineyard manager to restrict yields, creating small, concentrated berries. Thoughtful canopy management and intensive irrigation strategies were implemented. Cool fall nights preserved freshness in the wine while continuing to develop flavor. The fruit was hand-harvested early in the mornings throughout October.

Upon arriving at the winery, the fruit was hand sorted with 80% destemmed and berry sorted before it was added on top of 20% whole cluster fruit. The wine spent 30+ days on skins for extended maceration before being barreled down into 100% French oak (20% new). The wine was cellared for 20 months, with 5 barrels selected and carefully blended. The wine was bottled unfined and unfiltered to ensure purity and vibrancy. 113 cases produced.

For purity, a singular clone was used in the final blend of this 100% Grenache, clone 3.

“The 2022 Single Barrel ‘Royal Slope’ Grenache comes from the Thunderstone and Corfu Crossing Vineyards. The red florals are really empathic on the nose alongside bright strawberry an guava aromatics. The palate is plush, round and generous with a seamless texture. The flavor density here is astonishingly good.”

2021 SCARLINE SYRAH

The 2021 vintage had early bud break, small berries and clusters with low yields due to below-average precipitation and hot, windy conditions. The high temperature records in late June caused sugar advancement, but flavor development and phenolic ripeness lagged behind. Cool fall temperatures allowed flavors to catch up and sugar accumulation to plateau. White wines from this vintage are expressive, ripe, and rich, while the red wines display strong varietal typicity.

The 2021 Single Barrel Scarline Syrah is made from 100% Scarline vineyard. The vineyard sits on a limestone scar on the southwest-facing slope and tends to create wines of saturated color and intense concentration. The fruit was cold-soaked, fermented using a non-saccharomyces yeast, and left on skins for a full 30-day+ extended maceration before barreling down into a mixture of new and used French oak. After 21 months in barrel, the blend was bottled unfined and unfiltered.

“The 2021 ‘Scarline’ comes from a site that has two different Syrah clones planted (Joseph Phelps and Tablas Creek). The wine was stored in 75% new French oak prior to bottling. The aromatics are gorgeous with violets, black tea and Asian spices that parade with dense dark fruits and smoky accents. The palate is concentrated and heady with serious concentration and good underlying finesse. This is a Cab-lovers Syrah with its massive power. Enjoy this beautiful wine now and over the next ten plus years.”

NEW TECHNIQUES

New wines from a completely reimagined winemaking process.

The wines have more richness and depth due to maceration being 2-3 times longer. Fermentation temperatures are strictly monitored to match the balance of extraction to a specific site. Highlighting smaller, artisanal cooperages lends toward an oak profile that is aromatically and texturally more dynamic. Lastly, we put the wines together much later in their élevage so that time and thoughtfulness can be the drivers of the blend.



WINEMAKER ALEX STEWART

GROWN IN THE COLUMBIA VALLEY

Our grapes are grown across the Columbia Valley. Vines in the Royal Slope, Red Mountain, and Horse Heaven Hills AVAs all contribute to what makes Single Barrel such complex yet vibrant wine.

The valley is home to 50,000 acres of vines within 20 distinct AVAs. Contrary to the reputation of the Pacific Northwest, the valley only gets six inches of rainfall a year—as much as the Gobi desert. Our long and consistent growing season produces complex yet vibrant wines with world-class varietals ranging from Syrah to Chardonnay.
